Information for returning residential students who will move back when halls open

As a College, we are excited to welcome you back to campus. We hope that information contained in this document will help you prepare for your arrival on campus.

Move-In Information

The College's residential facilities officially open and you will be permitted to move into your campus room on **Friday, August 24, 2018, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., Saturday, August 25, 2018, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., and Sunday, August 26, 2018 between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m.** You are encouraged to attend the Spirit & Traditions Kick Off (more information below). If you have a compelling need to move into your room prior to this time, please refer to the link on the previous page outlining requests for early arrival.

Once you get to campus for move-in

*****If you chose to move-in on August 24, 25 or 26, you will go to the lobby of your residence hall to pick-up your room key and other pertinent information from the RA. The contact information for the RA conducting your key pick-up will be posted throughout your residence hall.*****

Please understand that parking is limited and, as such, please keep the following points in mind: (a) you may need to park in a different location on campus to check-in and then wait until an opening presents itself for unloading, and (b) to ease the traffic and unloading patterns, please move your vehicle to a parking space away from the hall after you have unloaded your belongings. Ample parking should be available in the parking lot located at the intersection of Vernon Street and College Avenue; this is the parking lot located "behind the bridge."

While this document outlines specific information regarding the move-in process, you will receive a separate email from the Office of Residential Education & Housing with your roommate information.
